**Synopsis:**

This proposed procurement is unrestricted. The Government intends to procure through Simplified Acquisition Method (commercial items). NAICS 325188; small business size standard 1,000 employees.

Requirements contract to provide approximately 1,750 tons of quicklime to the Dalecarlia Water Treatment Plant and 850 tons to the McMillan Water Treatment Plant, Washington Aqueduct Division, Washington, DC. The Quick Lime supplied shall contain no soluble material or organic substances in quantities capable of producing deleterious or injurious effects on the health of those consuming water that has been treated properly with the lime products. Quick Lime shall be certified as suitable for contact with or treatment of drinking water by an accredited certified organization in accordance with ANSI/NSF Standard 60, Drinking Water Chemicals - Health Effects.

Contract is for a one year period from 1 October 2005 through 30 September 2006. The total estimated amount is between \$250,000.00 and \$500,000.00.

All responsible sources may submit a quote which shall be considered by the agency. The media through which the Government chooses to issue this solicitation will be the internet only. The solicitation will be provided in an electronic format, free of charge, to all authenticated account holders of Federal Technical Data Solution System (FedTeDS) - a one-time registration process is required for vendors/contractors.
