Synopsis: This proposed procurement is 100% set aside for Service-Disabled Veteran Owned Small Businesses. The NAICS assigned for this procurement is 541611 with a size standard of \$6.5M. The performance period is for a base period of one (1) year with two one (1) year options. The contract awarded under this solicitation will be an indefinite delivery, time and materials contract.

The contractor will be responsible for providing acquisition and administrative technical support services to the Army's Privatization Programs Office and the US Army Corps of Engineers, Baltimore District.

The solicitation requires separate technical and cost proposals to be evaluated on the basis of best value. Competitive proposals will be evaluated based on the evaluation criteria set forth in the solicitation package.

It is imperative that all small disadvantaged businesses contact their cognizant Small Business Administration Office to obtain Small Disadvantaged Business Certification. Without SBA SDB certification, neither a prime contractor nor a federal agency can receive SDB credit when utilizing non-certified SDB contractors/subcontractors. The solicitation will be provided in an electronic format, free of charge, to all authenticated account holders of Federal Technical Data Solution System (FedTeDS)—a one-time registration process for

vendors/contractors—Accounts may only be attained by CCR-registered contractors/vendor, go to www.fedteds.gov for additional information.
