Synopsis: This proposed procurement is 100% Small Business Set Aside, NAICS 325120 with a size standard of 1,000 employees. Estimated cost is between \$25,000.00 and \$100,000.00 for Base and 4 Option Years.

This proposed procurement contains Options.

This requirement is for Propane (delivered). The USACE, Washington Aqueduct (WA) Division, Dalecarlia Water Treatment Plant (WTP) uses a diesel-powered dredge to support its mission of manufacturing potable drinking water. The WA Dredge uses propane as fuel but has a limited storage capacity of two 100-gallon tanks aboard. Based on security issues, and dredge location, any larger storage capacity is considered a security threat, therefore, deliveries will be unscheduled and in limited quantities. The requested propane supply action will offer an initial year plus 4 option years.

Delivery Location: USACE, Washington Aqueduct Division, 5900 MacArthur Blvd NW, Washington DC 20016, 2514: Dalecarlia Reservoir Forebay.

Delivery Conditions: propane shall be delivered directly to the USACE Dredge located in the Dalecarlia Reservoir Forebay. This requires the vendor to access the Dalecarlia Reservoir via the Spring Valley Gate on Little Falls road NW, proceed around the backside of the reservoir via access road which is an unsurfaced, undulating service road subject to prevailing weather and timbered conditions. Approximate distance around the reservoir to dredge location is ¾ of a mile one way.

The solicitation will be provided in an electronic format, free of charge, to all authenticated account holders of Federal Technical Data Solution System (FedTeDS)—a one-time registration process for vendors/contractors—Accounts may only be attained by CCR-registered contractors/vendor, go to www.fedteds.gov for additional information.
