Synopsis: This proposed procurement is unrestricted, NAICS 237990 size standard of \$31 Million. Estimated cost of services is between \$15,000,000.00 - \$25,000,000.00

Contractor shall furnish all labor, material and equipment necessary to Dredge approximately 2,500,000 cubic yards of material from the Craighill Entrance, Craighill Upper Range, Brewerton Channel, and Ft. McHenry Channel to a depth of 50 feet and width of 700 feet; Curtis Bay Channel to a depth of 50 feet and width of 400 feet; Cutoff Angle to a depth of 50 feet and width of 700-1,750 feet; Dundalk East Channel to a depth of 42 feet and width of 500 feet; Brewerton Channel Eastern Extension and Tolchester Channel to a depth of 35 feet and width of 600 feet. The material will be dredged by clamshell and scow, hydraulic pipeline, or hopper dredge and placed in the Hart-Miller Island Placement Facility and the Sarbanes Ecosystem Restoration Project at Poplar Island.
