Synopsis: This proposed procurement is unrestricted. The NAICS assigned for this procurement is 541611. The performance period is for a base period of one (1) year with four one (1) year options. There will be one Firm Fixed Priced Indefinite Delivery/Indefinite Quantity (ID/IQ) type contract awarded under this solicitation. The contractor will be responsible for providing the following services: The contractor will provide analytical services and support for the management capabilities and efficiencies of the Army for privatization and partnership initiatives, with specific emphasis on privatization, partnership, and/or other strategic sourcing programs. Explore opportunities to expand and negotiate privatization, partnerships, and other strategic sourcing business initiatives such as, energy, municipal services, historic properties adaptive reuse and other similar initiatives to implement better business practices. Provide consulting and support services to the Army's Privatization and Partnership Programs.

The solicitation requires separate technical and cost proposals as well as subcontracting plan evaluation for large business offerors, to be evaluated on the basis of best value. Competitive proposals will be

evaluated based on the evaluation criteria set forth in the solicitation package. As a minimum, technical evaluation criteria will include Management, Technical Capabilities, and Past Performance.
