**Synopsis:** The proposed procurement is 100% Small Business Set Aside; NAICS 237990 with a small business size standard of not to exceed \$33,500,000.00. The magnitude of this project is between \$1,000,000.00 and \$5,000,000.00.

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Baltimore District intends to Solicit and Award one contract for the construction project consisting of the Section 219 Nicholson II Sewer Project which consists of installation of approximately 14,500 LF of 1.5-inch low pressure lateral pipes from the main constructed under the Section 219 Nicholson Sewer Project to approximately 261 STEP/STEG units, to include associated electrical and mechanical work and site restoration. The STEP/STEG units include a septic tank, effluent pump (if required), effluent filter, level controls, and wiring from the tank units to the residence. Individual homeowners will be responsible to connect to the septic tank units and provide the electrical service. The construction limits will be confined to public right-of-way and private easement areas already obtained by the Nicholson Borough Authority.
