Synopsis: The proposed procurement is Small Business Set-Aside. NAICS Code: 236220, Size Standard is \$33,500,000.00. This procurement is being advertised as a Request for Proposal (RFP). Estimated range is \$10,000,000.00 to \$25,000,000.00 with a completion period not to exceed 365 calendar days from notice to proceed.

Description of work - The Early Site work Package will consist of, but is not limited to, sedimentation and erosion controls measures, construction fencing, housing demolition including abatement of hazardous materials, site demolition including utilities and paving, earthwork and grading, underground and aboveground steam line, underground natural gas line, underground water line, overhead electrical distribution, and sewer system. In support of excavation below 2 feet geophysical survey and clearance of unexploded ordnance will be a work requirement.

The Government is proposing using a **Lowest price technically acceptable** FAR 15.101-2 approach to select the Prime Contractor. An award will be made to the offeror whose proposal is determined to be the best value to the Government considering both price and technical factors.

It is imperative that all small disadvantaged businesses contact their cognizant Small Business Administration Office to obtain Small Disadvantaged Business Certification. Without SBA, SDB certification, a prime contractor nor a federal agency can receive SDB credit when utilizing non-certified SDB contractors/subcontractors.
