**Background:** Located near Odenton and along the Baltimore-Washington Parkway (MD Rt. 295), Fort Meade is in northwestern Anne Arundel County and within the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Congressional Districts. Fort Meade provides a base of operations for numerous strategic, tactical, and support organizations. The installation provides support and services for more than 78 partner organizations which include the National Security Agency, the Defense Information School, the Defense Information Systems Agency, the Defense Media Activity, and the U.S. Army Field Band.



The installation has served our country since 1917 when it was established by Congress as one of 16 cantonments built for troops drafted for the war with the Central Powers of Europe. During World War I, more than 100,000 men passed through Fort Meade. Its ranges and other training facilities were used by more than 200 units and approximately 3,500,000 men during World War II during which time Fort Meade reached a peak strength of 70,000. Since then, Fort Meade has returned to a build-up status on numerous occasions as it continues its transformation into a federal campus. The 2005 Base Realignment and Closure Act (BRAC) authorized more than \$500 million dollars of construction to support nearly 6,000 new military, civilian, and contractor workforce at Fort Meade.
