All depths refer to MLLW for the '83-'01 tidal epoch. This information represents the results of surveys made on the dates indicated and can only be as representing the general conditions at that time. Length of channel is reported to the nearest mile (actual length is 0.89 statute miles). Middle half equals 80% of channel width. Channel MH = E1472240.44,N560347.73 (4.3')
