**Dear Interested Party:**

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Baltimore District is updating the Master Plan, (herein referred to as plan) and preparing a draft Environmental Assessment (EA) for Jennings Randolph Lake Project located in Garrett County, Maryland, and Mineral County, West Virginia. The update will be performed in accordance with the January 2013 updates to the Engineer Regulation (ER) and Engineering Pamphlet (EP), and the November 2015 policy memorandum Revision to ER and EP 1130-2-550 Master Plans.

The plan is a vital tool produced and used by USACE to guide the responsible stewardship of USACE-administered lands and resources for the benefit of present and future generations. The Plan presents an inventory and analysis of land resources, resource management objectives, land use classifications, resource use plan for each land use classification, current and projected park facility needs, an analysis of existing and anticipated resource use, and anticipated influences on overall project operation and management. The plan also provides direction for appropriate management, use, development, enhancement, protection, and conservation of the natural, cultural, and manmade resources at the Jennings Randolph Lake project.

An initial public meeting will be held on September 25, 2018 at the Mineral County Health Department, from 6 p.m. to 9 p.m. This public meeting is intended to introduce the project to the public and gather feedback on development ideas and interests for Jennings Randolph Lake.
