

## **4825 Glenbrook Road Weekly Update for Aug. 22, 2014**

Crews continued preparing the site for the tent move activities. Part of this week and next week's work consists of backfilling the excavation area under the first tent location. This area will be needed to continue to support our efforts at the site. Starting today, people passing by the site might see the front of tent is rolled up. Our team needs to have the front and back of the tent rolled up about 8 feet to properly ventilate carbon monoxide from the tent during the backfill operations. There are no risks to the community from the backfilling operations.

Additionally, we received the final confirmation soil samples from the competent saprolite and bedrock under the first tent location. The sample results all came back clean.

Attached are two photos of the current work. One shows the crew inside the tent covering the exposed footer prior to backfilling the previously excavated area. The other photo shows the tent rolled up for ventilation.

Safety continues to be our number one priority at the site. Throughout every phase of the project, all necessary precautions are taken to ensure the safety of the site workers, the residents of the community, and those driving by.
