**SUBJECT: NATIONWIDE PERMIT REISSUANCE REQUEST FOR
COMMENTS AND PUBLIC HEARING**

Due to the tragic events that occurred in New York City and Washington, D.C. on September 11, 2001, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Office of the Chief of Engineers postponed the Nationwide Permit (NWP) Public Hearing which was originally scheduled for September 12, 2001. The referenced hearing has been rescheduled for September 26, 2001, at 12:30 PM in the GAO Building, 7th floor auditorium. The GAO Building is located at 441 G Street, N. W., Washington, D.C. 20314-1000. The purpose of the hearing is to solicit public comments; both oral and written, on the NWP Program as a whole or on individually proposed NWPs on a national level.
