
2nd Maryland Consultants Workshop



Topics to be discussed include:

1. **Administrative Appeals Process:** An overview of the process for appealing final Corps jurisdictional determinations (JDs) and permit decisions.
2. **Baltimore District Website:** An overview of the Regulatory website.
3. **Court Cases:** Recent court decisions related to the Regulatory program.
4. **Permit Conditions:** An overview of permit conditions with emphasis on permit compliance and transferring permits.
5. **Jurisdiction:** JD checklist, JD expiration (Regulatory Guidance Letter 90-6), definition of fill material, jurisdictional streams, and trinomials (wetland plants of the Northeast region with multiple wetland indicator status designations).
6. **Mitigation:** An overview of the Baltimore District's draft proposed mitigation and monitoring guidelines advertised on Special Public Notice 03-21R dated December 29, 2003.

From Washington or Annapolis: Take Route 50 east to exit 27, Route 2 north (Governor Ritchie Highway) toward Baltimore. Stay on Route 2 for about three miles. Turn right on College Parkway. The first right turn is the campus entrance.

From Baltimore: From Interstate 695 take exit 2, Route 10 toward Severna Park. Stay on Route 10 until it ends at Route 2 (Governor Ritchie Highway). Follow Route 2 south about five miles. Turn left on College Parkway. The first right turn is the campus entrance.
