



Background:

Fort Indiantown Gap is located in Lebanon Count, PA. It is located adjacent to Interstate 81, 23 miles (37 km) northeast of Harrisburg just north of the northern terminus of Pennsylvania Rt 934 at I-81's Exit 85. The installation is an active National Guard Training Center and serves as headquarters for the Pennsylvania Department of Military and Veterans Affairs and the Pennsylvania National Guard The Fort Indiantown Gap Military Reservation is protected by a full-time police force. The post includes 18,000 acres (73 km²), with numerous ranges and training areas for the 28th Infantry Division, the 213th Area Support Group and the Eastern Army National Guard Aviation Training Site. The installation is also home to the Northeast Counterdrug Training Center (NCTC).
