



**DCPS Capital Improvement Program

**Noyes Elementary School  
2725 10<sup>th</sup> Street, N.E.  
Renovation / Addition**

**Background:**

Noyes elementary school is a 49,700 square foot school constructed in 1931 with a 1940 and 1960 addition. The school capacity is 472 students with a current enrollment of 325. The school was identified and approved for modernization in early 1999. In late 1999 DCPS completed city-wide Educational Specifications for new and fully modernized schools. In 2000 a site specific educational specification and feasibility study was completed for Noyes. This study recommended replacement of the school and was approved in the fall of 2000. The planned new school is programmed at 51,500 square feet with a student capacity of 360. Community review of schematic designs resulted in a decision to renovate the 1931 historical portion of the school and the existing auditorium and also to build a new addition. Swing space is Hamilton E.S. Expected occupancy date of the new Noyes is March 2004.



**Status:**

This school is currently in the construction phase. The designer was McKissack and McKissack of Washington, D.C. Swing space renovations are complete at Hamilton. The construction contract was awarded to Sigal Construction of Washington, D.C. Groundbreaking ceremony was held in May 2002. Construction completion is 50%.
