Corps of Engineers to Hold Media Day at Spring Valley

BALTIMORE, MD--The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Baltimore District, will hold a media day on Tuesday, March 16 at 1 p.m., to discuss the Corps' planned intrusive investigation scheduled for later this month at one property on Glenbrook Road in the Spring Valley neighborhood of Washington, D.C.
