**Boat Launch Fees Waived at
Jennings Randolph Lake until May 1**

Jennings Randolph Lake, W.V.-The U. S. Army Corps of Engineers at Jennings Randolph Lake announced today that boat ramps at Jennings Randolph Lake are now open daily for the remainder of the season and launch fees are being waived until May 1, 2005.

The Corps boat launch is alongside Howell Run just off West Virginia State Route 46, three miles north of Elk Garden, West Virginia.

After May 1, 2005 passes will cost \$30 and will be valid for 12 months from the date of purchase. Duplicate passes will no longer be issued as the hanging tag is valid in any vehicle the pass purchaser owns.

Tags are honored at all Corps of Engineers operated facilities across the nation.
