Ribbon Cutting Ceremony at Tioga-Hammond/ Cowanesque Lakes on May 22

Tioga, Pa.-Congressman John E. Peterson (R-PA) and U.S Army Corps of Engineers, Baltimore District Commander, Col. Robert Davis will participate in a special ribbon cutting ceremony to celebrate the official opening of several recreation improvements at Tioga-Hammond and Cowanesque Lakes, Tioga, Pa., Sunday, May 22nd at 11:30 a.m.

The recreation improvements are part of the approved Tioga-Hammond and Cowanesque Lakes master plan, a document that helps the Corps carry out its responsibilities to preserve, conserve, restore, maintain, manage and develop project lands, waters and associated resources.

New facilities at Tioga-Hammond Lakes include a shower house, universal access fishing pier, fish cleaning station, playground, paving and signs. Improvements at Cowanesque Lake include upgraded campsites, expanded mooring slips, expanded shower house, universal access fishing pier, signs, fish cleaning station, and universal access to a playground.
