Raystown Lake sells out of Deer Management Assistance Program tags

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Raystown Lake announced today that it has completed the distribution of Deer Management Assistance Program, or DMAP, tags for the 2005/2006 hunting season. Raystown staff distributed 1,150 coupons through both a mail-in and walk-in registration.

Applicants who received coupons are required by law to redeem them for DMAP licenses from the Pennsylvania Game Commission. Reporting under the DMAP program is also mandatory regardless of whether a DMAP license holder harvests a deer. Information on reporting can be found at www.pgc.state.pa.us.
