Corps to hold Spring Valley public meeting

BALTIMORE – A community-wide meeting about the Spring Valley Formerly Used Defense Site will be held **Tuesday, Oct. 18 at 7 p.m.** in the **Great Hall of the Metropolitan Memorial United Methodist Church**, 3401 Nebraska Avenue Northwest in Washington, D.C., by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. The public is invited to attend.

Updates on the Formerly Used Defense Site's ongoing investigations will include the recent groundwater study activities, the Lot 18 dig, removal of arsenic-affected soil, the phytoremediation study and other ongoing projects.

These issues are regularly discussed with the Spring Valley Restoration Advisory Board, which meets monthly. Periodically, the Corps holds a public meeting to keep the broader community informed.

The Army's American University Experiment Station was located in the Spring Valley area in the World War I era. The current mission is to identify, investigate and remove or remediate threats to human health, safety or the environment resulting from past military activities there.
