### Shaw Beach to close due to low water levels

**Jennings Randolph Lake, W.Va.** — The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Jennings Randolph Lake plan to close the Shaw Beach recreation area for safety reasons after unusually dry conditions have caused low water conditions.

The beach will close once the water falls to an elevation of 1,455 feet mean sea level. At this elevation, the designated swim area is no longer usable. The beach will reopen to the public for day use once its waters reach a safe elevation level.

Shaw Beach is located next to the West Virginia overlook, just off state Route 46, five miles north of Elk Garden, W.Va.
