Raystown Lake to open High Germany Road for youth, regular spring gobbler season

Raystown Lake, Pa. — The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers at Raystown Lake will open the High Germany Road access road on the dates below.

- The High Germany Road (Gate 28 – Nancy’s Camp Service Road) will be open on April 19 to accommodate special season access for eligible junior and mentor hunters.
- It will also be open from April 26 to May 26 for the regular spring gobbler season.

The Corps makes decisions to close or not to open this gated road depending on weather considerations, road conditions and special activities such as logging operations. The public should be aware that there is no off-season maintenance on this roadway. Vehicle operators travel at their own risk. All Pennsylvania Game Commission and Corps of Engineers regulations apply.
