B. REQUIRED ADDITIONAL COMMENTS TO SUPPORT JD. EXPLAIN RATIONALE FOR DETERMINATION THAT THE

REVIEW AREA ONLY INCLUDES DRY LAND: **The site is mostly developed commercial property comprised of buildings are parking lots. There is a stormwater feature located in the northern portion of the site. In addition there is a storm drain outfall which collected rainwater and runoff is directed. The stormwater outfall has a large concrete apron and a small channel has formed from the concentration of water. There was no water in the channel during the site visit and even though the channel had a bed and bank there was not obvious ordinary high water mark. The channel was determined to be an upland drainage feature. There were no other areas of review on the property.**
