Recreational programs and activities at USACE lakes also help strengthen family ties and friendships; provide opportunities for children to develop personal skills, social values, and self-esteem; and increase water safety.

#### **ECONOMIC BENEFITS**

#### **Economic Data in FY 2022**

Visitation per year resulted in:

- \$ 35,116,544 in visitor spending within 30 miles of the USACE lake
- \$ 24,092,269 in sales within 30 miles of the USACE lake
- 246 jobs within 30 miles of the USACE lake
- \$ 7,306,829 in labor income within 30 miles of the USACE lake
- \$ 10,892,688 in value added within 30 miles of the USACE lake
- \$ 4,443,341 in National Economic Development Benefits

With multiplier effects, visitor trip spending resulted in:

- \$ 36,160,979 in total sales
- 321 jobs
- \$ 10,942,045 in labor income
- \$ 17,009,930 in value added (wages & salaries, payroll benefits, profits, rents, and indirect business taxes)

#### **Benefits in Perspective**

The money spent by visitors to USACE lakes on trip expenses adds to the local and national economies by supporting jobs and generating income. Visitor spending represents a sizable component of the economy in many communities around USACE lakes.
