



FJ. Sayers Dam **U.S. Army Corps of Engineers**



Construction, 1965 - 1969









Crane Arrives for Sayers Dam, Gates Not Due until August



- Dam is 100 feet high, 1.3 miles long
- Authorized for flood risk management, recreation, and fish and wildlife management
- Controls drainage area of ~ 340 square miles, and reservoir has storage capacity of 99,000 acre-feet at spillway crest
- Cost \$30 million
- 1,730-acre lake for recreation
- Dept. of Conservation and Natural Resources leases 5,900 acres for year-round recreational use
- Federal recreation facilities completed in 1971
