Why

F.J. Sayers Dam is operated and maintained by the Army Corps of Engineers. Since its completion in 1969, it has prevented more than \$212 million in flood damages for downstream communities. The dam is named in memory of Private First Class Foster Joseph Sayers, a former resident of Centre County, who was awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor for his heroic service as a U.S. Army machine gunner in WWII. We honor this American hero and flood risk management project by opening our facilities to the public in their recognition.
