With support from the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Treasury is evaluating a Project Site at the Beltsville Agricultural Research Center (BARC) for the Proposed Action. The site under consideration is an approximately 122-acre parcel of land near the intersection of Poultry Road and Powder Mill Road. - Viewshed Analysis

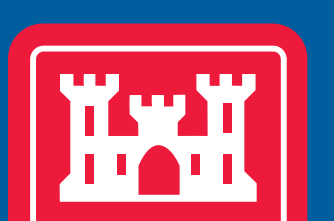
BEP Replacement Currency Production Facility
