
Treasury proposes to design and construct a more efficient, modern **Currency Production Facility at the Beltsville Agricultural Research** Center (BARC) on land authorized for transfer under the Agriculture

## Improvement Act of 2018 (aka, the 2018 Farm Bill).

Should Treasury implement the Proposed Action, construction would start in 2021/2022 and be followed by the phased transition of personnel and operations from the Bureau of Engraving and Printing's (BEP's) current Washington, DC Facility from 2025 to 2029.

### **About the Proposed Action**

 Manufacturing, warehouse, storage, security, and administrative operations



- Development footprint of approximately 1 million square feet
- Building height range of 40 to 50 feet
- On-site air and wastewater treatment
- 1,600 employees working in shifts (6:30 am, 2:30 pm, and 10:30 pm)
- Site access from new entrance road off of Powder Mill Road
- Enhances and incorporates forest buffer zones

 Low impact development/green infrastructure techniques and designs
