

# Environmental Impact Reduction

DEIS – Sections 2.2.4 and 5.5

Treasury has incorporated many measures into the Proposed Action to minimize environmental impacts.

<b>Environmental Protection Measures (EPMs):</b>	Non-regulatory measures that Treasury <u>would implement</u> to reduce potential adverse impacts.
<b>Regulatory Compliance Measures (RCMs):</b>	<u>Project requirements</u> in accordance with applicable laws/regulations.
<b>Mitigation Measures:</b>	Additional measures that Treasury <u>could implement</u> to further reduce adverse impacts.

**EPMs and RCMs are included in the Proposed Action.** Mitigation measures **may** be implemented if Treasury finds them practical and warranted.

## Example EPMs and RCMs (Included as Part of the Proposed Action)

- Complete consultation requirements, obtain permits, and complete mandatory mitigation under the Clean Water Act, Endangered Species Act, and National Historic Preservation Act
- Comply with Maryland’s Forest Conservation Act, National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System regulations, and air quality requirements
- Install privacy fencing along Odell Road and the proposed entrance road during construction
- Prepare a noise suppression plan for construction
- Revegetate disturbed areas with native species
- Cover dump truck beds and unpaved roads to minimize fugitive dust emissions
- Keep construction staging areas at least 100 feet away from surface water

## Example Potential Mitigation Measures

- Develop an exterior lighting plan for the Proposed Action to minimize off-site light pollution
- Apply voluntary conservation measures to reduce potential impacts to the northern long-eared bat

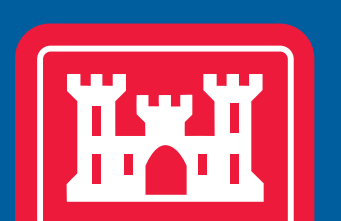
