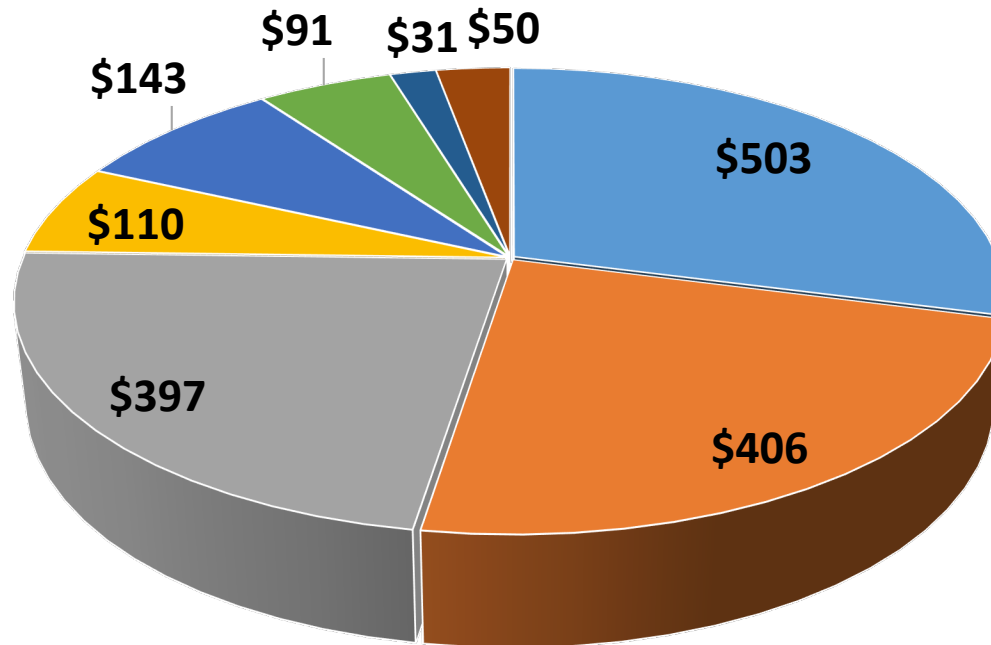

 - Click the all award data field and then select Contract Opportunities or the desired search category
 - The I'm looking for text box can be left empty
 - Keyword(s) can be added on the next search screen
 - » Metadata fields such as NAICS, PSC, and other filters can also be added

 - If searching for U.S. Army Corps of Engineers only, then a keyword should be **W2SD**
- Sort by field options
 - Relevance (based on keywords and metadata)
 - Title of Notice
 - Last Update
- Red arrow minimizes or opens the Blue definition section on top of search page



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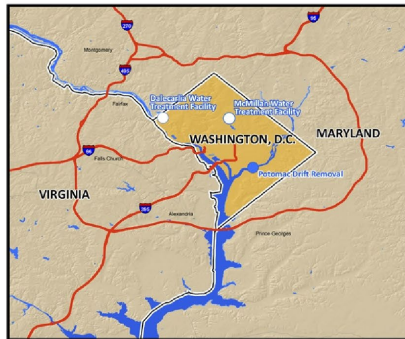

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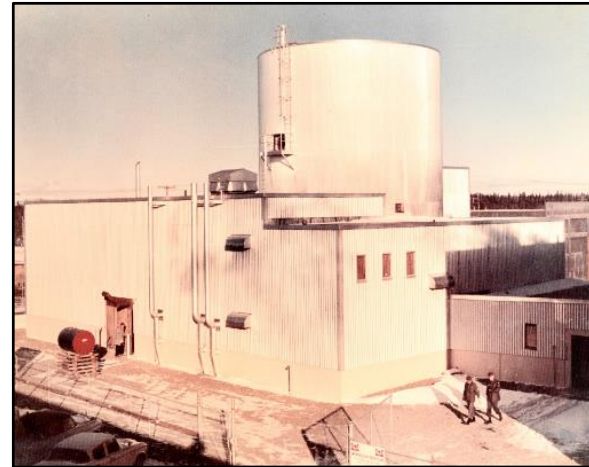


SM-1A DEACTIVATED NUCLEAR POWER PLANT DECOMMISSIONING
