

SM-1A Project Update, June 9, 2020

Dear SM-1A Stakeholders,

We wanted to reach out to provide a very quick contracting update on the SM-1A decommissioning effort. There are currently two sources sought notices on beta.sam.gov related to the project, seeking feedback from contractors as we prepare for future solicitations. One of which, expires tomorrow and the other expires in July.

The first Sources Sought is specific to the proposed utility segregation work at the deactivated SM-1A nuclear power plant at Fort Greely. This work involves the separation of the utilities within Bldg. 606 which is where the historical SM-1A nuclear reactor operations occurred.
