

STURGIS Project Update, January 28, 2016

Dear STURGIS Stakeholders,

As part of our ongoing communications with the community regarding progress on the STURGIS decommissioning and dismantlement project, we wanted to provide an update on our current status.

As you were previously informed, our team took a holiday break at the end of December. We had hoped to resume work at the site in early January, however work has not resumed at this time. The team is currently addressing operational issues related to the crane that we need to utilize to lift and remove large components from the STURGIS. We anticipate a solution to this issue in the near future and for operations to resume at some point in early March.

Once this issue is worked through, we will provide an updated schedule for completion based on this temporary delay.

Environmental monitoring has continued since her arrival in Port, and no evidence of radioactive material or increased radiation exposure from the STURGIS has been documented outside of the reactor containment area.

We appreciate the continued support of our local partners and stakeholders as we carry out this project.
