The project was initially dredged in 2003.

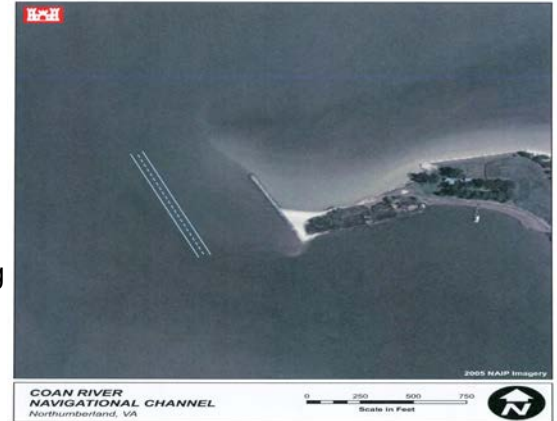
