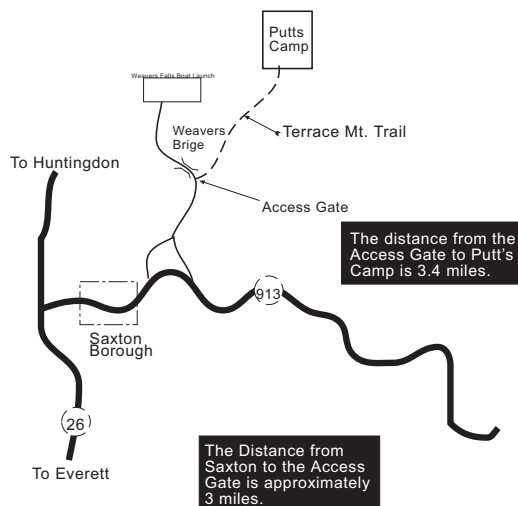

Putt's Camp is located on Raystown Lake near the southernmost end of the lake. Raystown Lake is a flood control lake completed in 1974 and has 110 miles of shoreline. The entire length of the lake stretches from the town of Saxton (Bedford County) to Huntingdon (Huntingdon County), a span of 29 miles.

Putt's Camp is a High Adventure primitive camping area operated by the Saxton Boy Scout Troop 471 / Laurel Highlands Council in cooperation with the the Baltimore District Army Corps of Engineers on a non-profit basis. Therefore, to keep our costs at a minimum we ask for your cooperation in abiding by the following rules and regulations.



Rules & Regulations

- √ Local Council Tour Plan with Certificate of Insurance from local council.
- √ A Signed "Agreement of Use"
- √ Garbage must be removed from campground. Pack-it-in, Pack-it-Out.
- √ No cutting of standing trees, please use downed wood only. Note: There is plenty of firewood available.
- √ Camp only in designated areas.
- √ Park vehicles in designated areas only.
- √ Do not move fire rings.
- √ Please double check for tent stakes, they create a hazard when mowing.
- √ Non-combustible material is not to be left in fire rings.

Fees: Rate - \$2.50/person/night \$50.00 minimum fee/stay. An additional \$50.00 reservation fee must be paid prior to your arrival. The \$50.00 reservation fee will be refunded on the satisfactory inspection of the camp or notification of cancellation prior to one week before your arrival. BSA Tour Plans are required.

Access: The camping area can be reached by hiking trail, by motor vehicle (4 wheel drive recommended) via Terrace Mountain Trail (3.4 mi) or by boat (approximately 2.5mi.).
