

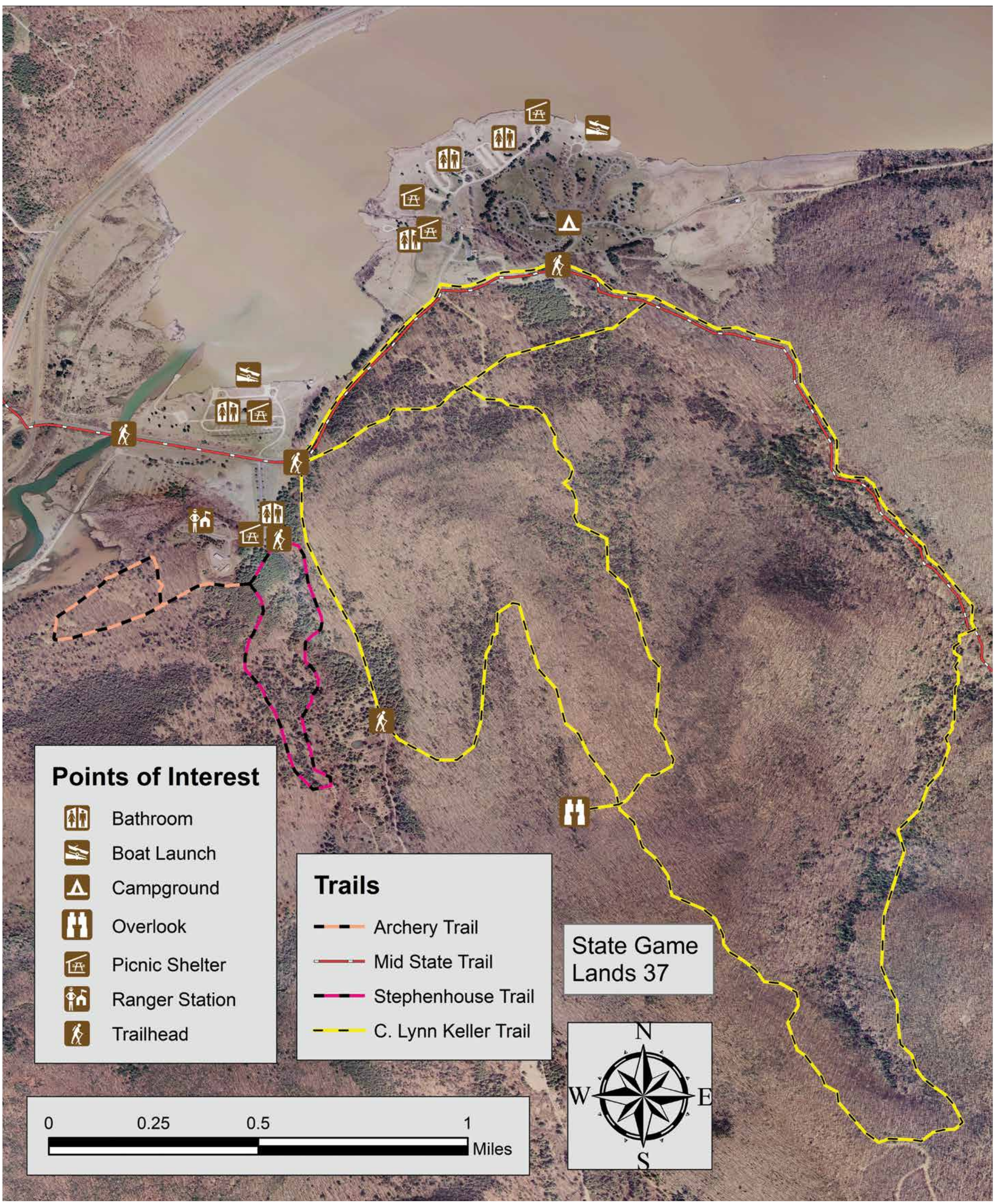

One of the joys of hiking is spying an interesting find along the way. Always leave your discoveries in place so others can enjoy them. In many protected areas, it is illegal to remove natural objects such as antlers, petrified wood or colored rocks.

On public lands, the same ethic applies to cultural artifacts, which are safeguarded by the Archaeological Resources Protection Act. It is illegal to remove or disturb archeological sites, historic sites or artifacts such as pot shards, arrowheads, structures and even antique bottles.
