Dear Ms. Bachur:

The Pennsylvania Coastal Resource Management (CRM) Program has reviewed the information for the 2017 Reissuance of the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Nationwide Permits received in this office on January 6, 2016 along with the Final Suspensions and Final Regional Conditions for Pennsylvania announced on March 20, 2017.

Under 15 C.F.R. Part 930 Subpart C -- Consistency for Federal Agency Activities, the proposed activity is subject to CRM's federal consistency review. CRM requested public comment on the proposed activity in the February 4, 2017 issue of the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. No comments were received.

CRM hereby concurs that the 2017 Reissuance of the Nationwide Permits, along with their associated regional conditions, is consistent with our enforceable policies. This concurrence does not apply to any NWPs which have been suspended by USACE for use in Pennsylvania. Activities covered under these suspended NWPs may instead be authorized under PA State Programmatic General Permit 5 (PASPGP-5).

Please note that this determination pertains only to the federal consistency review requirements under the Federal Coastal Zone Management Act of 1972, as amended, and does not constitute a waiver from further Department of Environmental Protection review or other Departmental permits.
