--- Next Restoration Advisory Board Meeting - July 14, 2020

Due to health concerns surrounding COVID-19, our May RAB meeting has been cancelled. The presentation for this meeting will be uploaded on the project website. The next RAB meeting will tentatively be held on Tuesday, July 14th at 7 p.m. These meetings are open to the public. Currently, the RAB meets every other month for 60-90 minutes in the 'Undercroft' meeting room at St. David's Episcopal Church, 5150 Macomb Street NW, D.C.

(Please note - The St. David's Episcopal Church staff have asked that we refrain from using the outside stairwells as a safety precaution due to water issues, poor lighting, and lack of stairs with grips; and use the bell tower entrance (which has internal stairs and an elevator). There will be signs clearly posted to direct RAB meeting attendees to the new entrance. We thank you in advance for following the request of our hosts, the St. David's Episcopal Church.)

--- Final Site-Wide Decision Document Now Available:

The Final Site-Wide Decision Document is complete and is now available at the Information Repository and for download here on our site. The Decision Document outlines the selected remedies to address both unacceptable risks posed by soil contamination and unacceptable explosive hazards posed by the possible presence of munitions and explosives of concern (MEC).

Contractor/Support Updates:

- Weston Solutions (Site Wide) and AECOM (Groundwater) remain the primary remediation contractors at the start of FY 2023
- ERT (Community Outreach) and DGI (TAPP Contractor) finished their work as of 30 Sep 2022, and no longer work on the project
- Chenega Infinity remains the security contractor for Spring Valley, will work through Aug 2023
- Ames 1 has joined the Spring Valley team, and will be providing facility maintenance and support services to the Federal Property site for up to three years if needed
- USACE will potentially hire a new security contractor and a new remediation contractor (PSB Hillside phase) in FY 2023

RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES




- **Property Availability** – None during this reporting period.

RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES – RA MEC/MD FINDS






SITE-WIDE REMEDIAL ACTION

Final Survey effort at 92 Residential Properties & 13 Federal/City Lots:

- Currently working on 1 residential property in the remedial action process.
- 91 civil surveys and 91 arborist surveys have been completed.
- 91 properties have been visited by the geophysicist team, who provide technical recommendations on plant removal.
- Vegetation removal (if needed) performed at 91 private properties and 13 City/Fed lots.
- Geophysical surveys completed at 91 private properties and 13 City/Fed lots off Dalecarlia Parkway.
- Anomaly removal completed at 91 private properties and 13 City/Fed lots off Dalecarlia Parkway.
- Issued 91 Assurance Letters.





SITE-WIDE REMEDIAL ACTION

Tentative Schedule



Fall 2022

- Work with remaining homeowners to close out any pending tasks
- Tree removal at 1 property is being scheduled for October
- Complete final remedial actions inside fence-line in Dalecarlia Woods



PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING UPDATE

- Demobilization from the PSB site on 16 April 2021.
- Completed E&S Control Inspections every other week, will continue through December 2022.
- PSB slope and soil benches are vegetated and stable.
- Mowing is conducted at the PSB Site during the growing season
- PSB Draft Final was distributed to the Partners on September 9th, 2022







GROUNDWATER STUDY



- UACE contractor AECOM is developing the CERCLA documentation, including the Groundwater Addendum to the Remedial Investigation Report, a No Action Proposed Plan, and a No Action Decision Document.
- The Draft Remedial Investigation Addendum has been submitted to the USACE Environmental and Munitions Center of Expertise (EMCX) for review.
- USACE is planning a Spring/Summer 2023 Public Meeting for Groundwater

Future RAB Meetings



- After tonight's meeting, USACE will not be able to support many RAB meetings in 2023. USACE will have two meetings in 2023 (April & October).
- The main projects left for RAB updates are the Site-Wide Remediation (PSB and the 92 residential properties and 13 Federal/City lots) and Groundwater.
- It is likely that RAB meetings will be discontinued in 2024.
