--- Next Restoration Advisory Board Meeting - July 14, 2020

#### --- Final Site-Wide Decision Document Now Available:

The Decision Document outlines the selected remedies to address both unacceptable risks posed by soil contamination and unacceptable explosive hazards posed by the possible presence of munitions and explosives of concern (MEC).



Advanced Geophysical Classification (AGC) survey efforts are underway as final preparation steps wrap up with the last group of homeowners.






## SITE-WIDE REMEDIAL ACTION

#### Final Survey effort at 92 Residential Properties & 13 Federal/City Lots:

- Currently working on 5 residential properties at different stages of the remedial action process.
- 90 civil surveys and 90 arborist surveys have been completed.
- 90 properties have been visited by the geophysicist team, who provide technical recommendations on plant removal.
- Vegetation has been removed from 88 private properties and 13 City/Fed lots.
- Geophysical surveys completed at 85 private properties and 13 City/Fed lots off Dalecarlia Parkway.
- Anomaly removal completed at 85 private properties and 13 City/Fed lots off Dalecarlia Parkway.
- Issued 85 Assurance Letters.






## SITE-WIDE REMEDIAL ACTION (RA)

# SITE-WIDE REMEDIAL ACTION



#### **Tentative Schedule**

Summer 2021	<ul> <li>Obtain Rights-of-Entries from remaining two properties.</li> <li>Finalize plant removal plans with the last group of homeowners and conduct plant removal at private properties in preparation for geophysical surveys.</li> <li>Begin subsequent round of geophysical surveys.</li> </ul>
Fall 2021	<ul> <li>Complete round of anomaly removal efforts.</li> <li>Begin subsequent Final Restoration Site walks with final group of homeowners.</li> </ul>








# **AU'S FORMER PUBLIC SAFETY BUILDING (PSB)**

The remaining investigation of the surrounding hillside of the former PSB site remains inactive while contract details for further work are finalized. The work at this site is expected to resume in late 2021. The PSB site remains secure, and a small team will continue to monitor and repair the erosion and sediment controls until work resumes.

#### **Next Steps:**

- Finalize administrative contract actions
- Complete the remaining work at the PSB Slope
- Begin landscape restoration efforts

All landscape restoration of the groundcover and the remaining permanent fencing installation has been completed at the Glenbrook project area.

The final hydroseeding effort was completed in early August to ensure the grass groundcover is well established throughout the site as the Glenbrook Road project team demobilized and the lot was returned to the property owner.

Additionally, all remaining fencing has been installed at Glenbrook Rd.


