

11. FINDINGS AND CONCLUSION

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Sacramento District updated the June 29th, 2021 Lehi Utah environmental baseline survey per paragraph 4.5 ASTM D-6008-96- *Standard Practice for Conducting Environmental Baseline Surveys* of parcels 58-004-0069, 58-004-0045, 58-005-0086, 58004-0070, 58-021-0418, and 58-021-0361 to evaluate the proposed site use on 6/12/2022. Upon completion of the site reconnaissance and review of environmental document records there is no evidence supporting a release of contaminants. These parcels are characterized as Environmental Condition of Property Area Type 1 in accordance with ASTM D5746-98- *Standard Classification of Environmental Condition of Property Area Types for Defense Base Closure and Realignment Facilities*: an area or parcel of real property where no release, or disposal of hazardous substances or petroleum products or their derivatives has occurred (including no migration of these substances from adjacent properties).

12. JUSTIFICATION AND DISCUSSION

The onsite reconnaissance and records review were used to determine whether a release or potential release of contaminants has occurred and if additional investigation or action is required. During the onsite reconnaissance there were no signs of release or potential release of contaminants. In addition, the records review analyzed the subject parcels and adjacent properties for release, potential release, or migration of contaminants. There were no records of release, potential release, or migration of contaminants.

13. RECOMMENDATIONS

Additional investigation or action is not required.
