The Washington Aqueduct produces drinking water for over 1 million citizens living, working or visiting in the District of Columbia, Arlington County, Virginia and the City of Falls Church, Virginia. The Aqueduct must significantly reduce or eliminate its practice of returning treatment residuals to the Potomac River to comply with a permit recently issued by the Environmental Protection Agency. These residuals are river sediment and solid materials that are removed from the water by using a coagulant.
